The following items represent additional information provided, changes, amendments or clarifications to the Contract Bid Documents for the above referenced project:

QUESTION FROM SITE VISIT (1/24/19)

Some focuses of our project:

- Westerly High School is our biggest priority.
- We want to use existing infrastructure (switches/wiring) where possible at all buildings.
- At the High School, we will be going towards a 1:1 solution. On average we have between 800-850 students plus 110 staff. All teachers at the moment have a chromebook.

Questions to Asbestos:

- Springbrook Elementary has none.
- Westerly High School - Most removed but some may be on piping which is covered/encapsulated.
- Dunns Corner Elementary - Floor tile, I-beams, and decking may have some.

What is our preferred fire stop:

- 3M

Current WAP counts at each building:

- DCS: 28 WAPs
- SES: 16 WAPs
- WHS (both buildings): 89 WAPs

What UPSs are currently in use:

- Dell UPS 1920T (service tag: 7H04TS1)

Cabling at locations:

- WHS will have CAT5e/CAT6.
- Our elementary schools may or may not have CAT5e/CAT6.

Question about POE and power issues:

- We had an issue at our WMS location but is unknown if we will have additional power issues powering any new number of WAPs. This is something to consider though.
- Most of our locations and closets use HP Procurve E5406 chassis for switching.

Dunns Corner networking closet discussion:

- Currently the network closet is in a janitor wash room. We would be interested in having two scenarios quoted out where we use the existing location and switching in the closet, and a second where the equipment is moved into the new location in the closet with the server rack.

Ceilings and existing wiring:

- All locations have drop ceilings.
- All rooms already have at least one or two Ethernet drops, sometimes being attached to a WAP.

Question on network use/expectation in Gym/Auditoriums:

- Again, our highest priority is the High School, the gym and auditoriums are used for large community events, graduations, outside speakers come in, and etc. where the rooms are filled, and people are standing on the side of the rooms. We want to ensure all occupants have the ability to utilize their devices. We filter content and QOS, so people should not be streaming games or videos all concurrently but simply have access to Gmail, web browsing, and Facebook at times.
- The same goes to other gyms and auditoriums at Springbrook and Dunns Corner Elementary schools but will have a significantly less number of people.
