On July 14, 2021 the Governor signed an amendment to RIGL Section 44-3-4. Any person who served in uniform between 1947 through 1991 is eligible for the Veteran exemption even if they were not deployed to the area of conflict. The amendment is limited to veterans serving during that specific time period. Those that served during WWI, WWII, Korea and Vietnam still receive the exemption, that has not changed.
